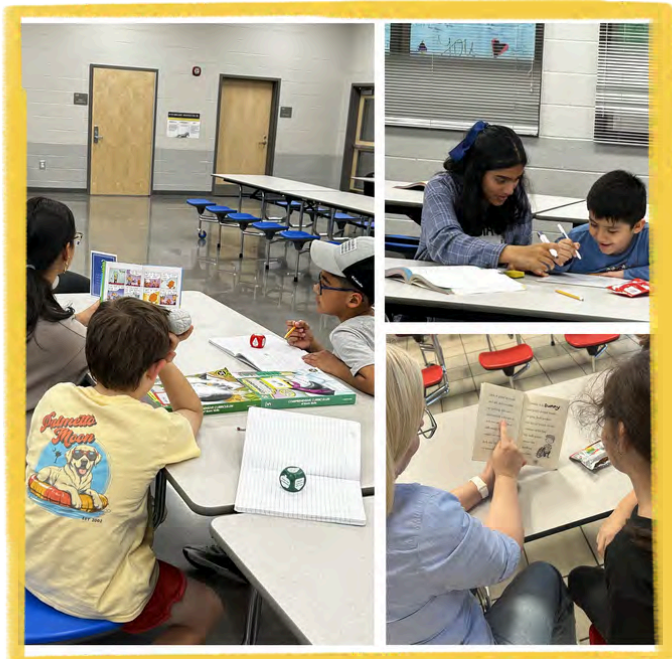


# 2026 SUMMER MAS PROGRAM



The MAS Program (Mentoring After School) is a free program for elementary school students designed to support both academic and personal growth. Students meet once a week with volunteer mentors in a structured and supportive environment.

Each student receives a Summer Bridge workbook and follows a consistent schedule that includes writing, reading, and additional academic support. The program focuses on building social and emotional skills and creating consistent, positive connections with mentors.

The Summer MAS program also reinforces learning from the previous school year and helps prevent summer learning loss, better preparing students for a strong and confident start to the new school year.

Through weekly meetings and meaningful mentorship, MAS helps students strengthen their academic abilities while growing in confidence.
