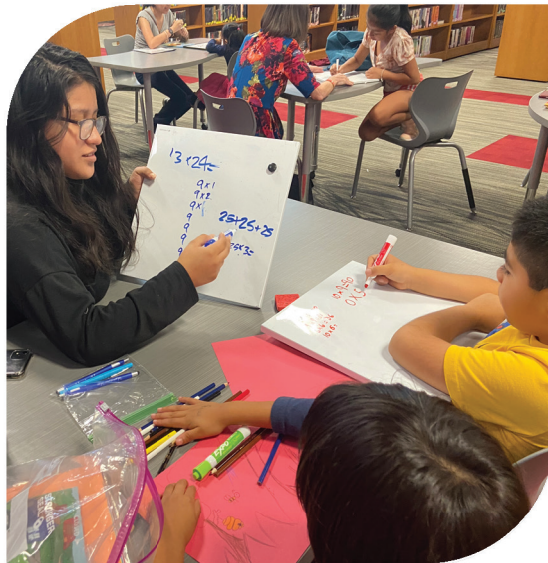

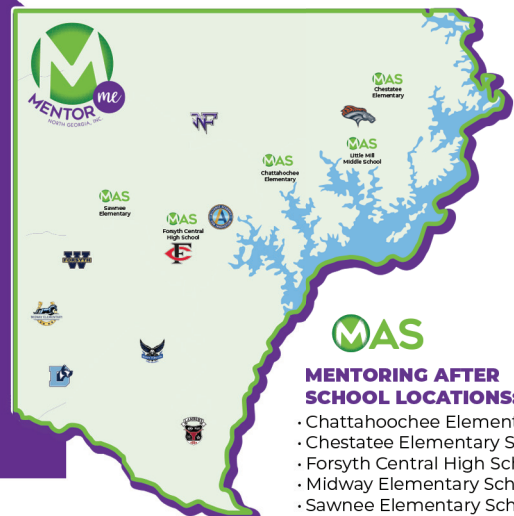
### MENTORING AFTER SCHOOL OVERVIEW
